Spring is quickly approaching, and the next few weeks are the optimal time to install new mulch on your property. We recommend replenishing your beds with mulch every 1 to 2 years to maintain a layer at least 2" thick.



In addition to beautifying your landscape by bringing a pop of color and freshness to your property, the benefits include:

- Water conservation
- Weed suppression
- Reduces the need to apply herbicides
- Provides nutrients for your plants
- Protects irrigation drip system from sun damage and foot traffic
- Covers or fills potential tripping hazards
- Prevents soil erosion

• Playground mulch provides a protective surface to reduce the risk of injuries (and State law requires a certified playground fiber be maintained 12" thick)
