We are currently seeking a **Landscape Irrigation Technician** within our Maintenance Division who will report directly to the Production Manager. This non-exempt position performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled tasks, involving the installation, troubleshooting, and repair of irrigation systems (e.g., valves, controllers, mainlines, and laterals).

Responsibilities:

- Implementing, troubleshooting, and repairing moderately-complex irrigation systems (e.g., valves, controllers, mainlines, laterals).
- Maintains tools and equipment to ensure safety and attends safety meetings.
- Maintains parts inventory on vehicle.
- Completes Irrigation Reports and Service Requests and is available for "on call" emergencies.
- Basic knowledge of computerized irrigation systems; installs, programs, and monitors computerized, centralized, and large-scale (i.e., 25 or more clocks) irrigation systems.
- Provides excellent service (e.g., accurate, complete, and timely) to clients, work-site partners, and company staff in a courteous and efficient manner.
- Performs grounds maintenance functions (e.g., pulling weeds, raking leaves) using hand tools (e.g., pick, shovel) or landscape equipment (e.g., lawn mowers, weed eaters) on a limited basis, and plants and waters vegetation.

- Safe work practices; moderately-complex irrigation systems (e.g., valves, controllers, tracing, mainlines, laterals); proper grounds maintenance using landscape equipment and hand tools safely; basic mathematics; water management; various plants and their proper care; blueprints and CPR; basic gardening principles (e.g., pruning, planting, watering); administrative processes (e.g., Irrigation Reports and Service Requests); computerized, centralized, and large-scale (i.e., 25 or more clocks) irrigation systems; elementary computer skills.
