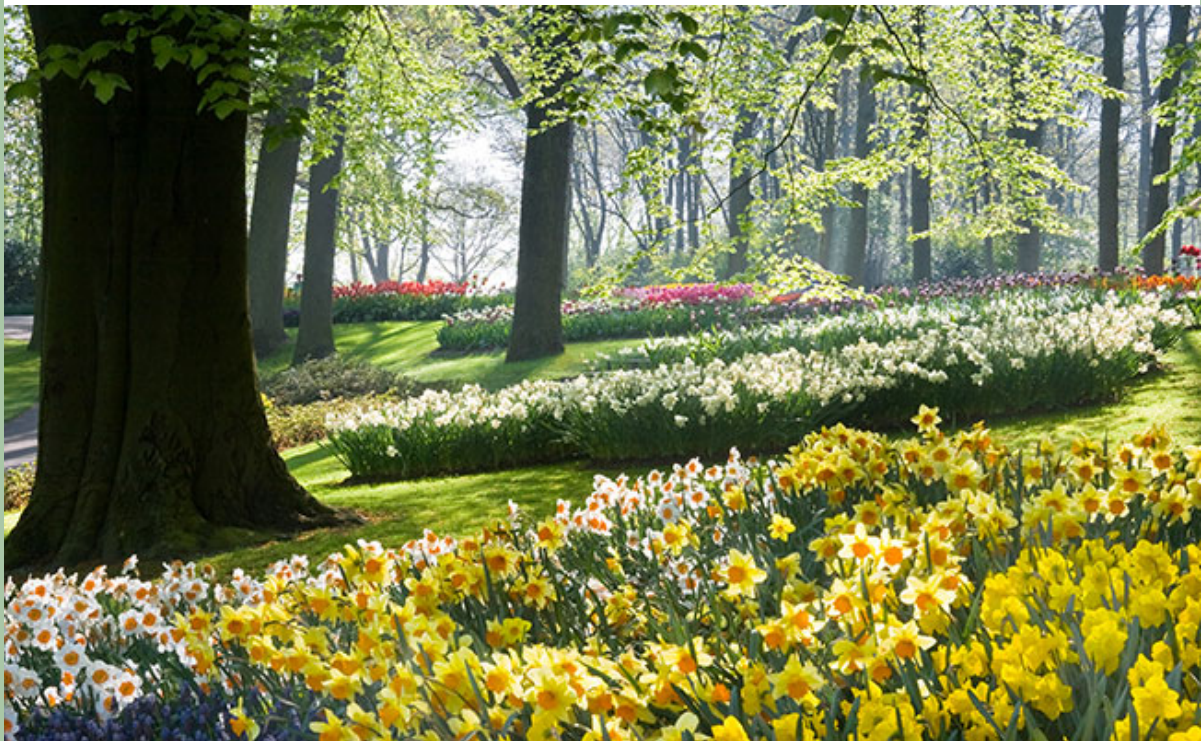

March Mulch Madness

Mulching is an extremely valuable tool and a key component in the health and happiness of your landscape. A fresh, well-maintained layer of mulch will have a huge impact on your landscape and provide a number of key benefits, including but not limited to the following:

- Moisture retention
- Soil erosion prevention
- Increased root growth
- Weed suppression and prevention
- Regulated soil temperatures
- Improved soil health



For optimal results, we recommend reapplying a fresh layer of mulch at least every other year during late winter or early spring, typically after heavy pruning and leaf pickup are finished.
